

Participation Requirement for:

Participation in the Hendricks County 4-H Dog Project: Required form to enroll in the dog project.

- 1.) 4-H Enrollment form must be on file at the Extension Office and enrollment fees paid before you can attend classes.

You will be responsible for keeping your information updated at the 4-H office and letting them know that your child is in the dog club so they can provide us with an updated roster with current information throughout the year. Information will be sent out by e-mail from the extension office - so update that info as needed with the 4-H extension office. The information on your vet form is the only information we have until the extension office gets all of the information typed in and new rosters given to the Project leader.

Participation in Training Sessions in the Hendricks County 4-H Dog Project: Above form plus

- 2.) State of Indiana 4-H Vet form #671 filled out from your vet and a Rabies certificate

New Members –

- A.) Shots given before 9/1 of the previous year will need to provide us with a color coded vet form from the previous year with the original rabies certificate to begin classes. When your shots expire, you will then need to have your vet fill out the current year's vet form and the original rabies certificate.
- B.) Shots given after 9/1/last year will need to provide us with a current years vet form and the original rabies certificate to begin classes.

Returning Members-

- A.) You will need to have a valid vet form #671 and a rabies certificate on file from your vet before you can bring your dog to classes. If you do not know when your shots are due you need to check before you start classes. Your dog will not be allowed to attend classes if your vet form and rabies certificate is not up-to-date. This is your responsibility. Vet forms will be available at Training classes.

**We recommend that you make a copy of your vet form/rabies certificate and file it in your folder so you know from year to year when your shots are due.*

**If you attend any fun matches you will also need to take a copy of your vet form along with proof of vaccination.*

- *Rabies certificate must include name and address of animal's owner, species, sex, and age of animal vaccinated, product name, lot number or serial number of the vaccine used, number of the tag issued under subdivision(3), name of veterinarian completing the vaccination and his or her Indiana veterinary license number and signature.*

Requirements for Showing your dog at the Hendricks County 4-H fair: All of the above forms are required to be on file in order to show your dog at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair plus:

3.) Completed 7 exercises in your activity book and turned it into your leader by the deadline date 7/1 for the dog club.

4.) Hendricks County 4-H Fair Registration form (# CO 4-H Reg) turned in by the deadline date. Forms will be available in June at the check-in desk during training sessions.

5.) Completion Card – You will receive this after you turn in your Activity Book and it is checked by your leader. You must bring this to the 4-H fair when you are showing or checking in your projects.

Requirements for displaying a Dog Poster at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair:

You must have the following (**#1, #3 & #5**) completed forms or requirements from the list above in order to display your poster at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair.

Other rules that apply to showing at the County Fair can be found in the 4-H handbook.

Requirements for showing your Dog in the Indiana State Fair Dog Show:

#1 (Enrollment Form) from “Participation in the Hendricks County 4-H Dog Project”

#2 (Vet Form # 671) from “Participation in Training Sessions in the Hendricks County 4-H Dog Project: You must have the **original Vet form & rabies certificate** with all the signatures and dates filled out to enter vet check at the Indiana State Fair. There cannot be any missing information on the vet form. **The vet form must be signed by your Dog Project Leader**. Therefore you must have also completed:

#3 (Activity Book) from “Requirements for Showing your dog at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair”

6.) You must have entered the State Fair dog Show. Their online entry is highly recommended.

Rules for the Indiana State Fair along with entry information is located on the Hendricks County 4-H Dog Club’s website (www.hendricks4hdogclub.com) as well as the 2014 Indiana State Fair website.

Some requirements for the following year require that you have shown your dog at the county 4-H fair the year prior. Example: agility – requires that you show your dog in obedience one year, showing more than one dog – requires that you have shown a dog through the 2A level at previous 4-H fairs, and the Hoosier Award requires that you have shown in 2 disciplines for at least 2 years.
