

Stand for Exam

Judge: “Stand your dog and leave when ready”

Child – tells the dog to stay – then walks out about 6’ from the dog and turns and faces the dog.

Judge: Approaches the dog and touches the back 3 times in separate places and then steps back.

Judge: “Return to your dog”

Child- Returns to the dog by going around the dog and back to the heel position and waits.

Judge: “Exercise Finished”

Child – Heels the dog out 2 steps and praises the dog

*Things to watch for:

The dog should not move their feet after the child has told it to stay.

If the dog continually moves after the child has left then have the child move directly in front of the dog to do the exercise and each time it is done right they can move out a little further.

Watch for sits or movements after the child returns and before the judge has said exercise finished. This is why we must have the heel 2 steps then praise the dog.
